- If working at school: click on the **start menu** (looks like a window) from your school computer. Scroll down to **Power Library**
- If working from home: click on the url listed above, enter public library barcode number or **click get an eCard now!**
 1. Click **LIST ALL E-RESOURCES**
 2. Click **EBSCO BOOKS** (Book FLIX is geared towards Elementary School)
 3. Once you are logged in, you have the option to search by category or to type in a specific search. You may select a field to search by such as, title, author, subject, etc.
 4. Click on the PDF version, if you want to download the book you will need to create an additional EBSCOhost account.
